Listen First:

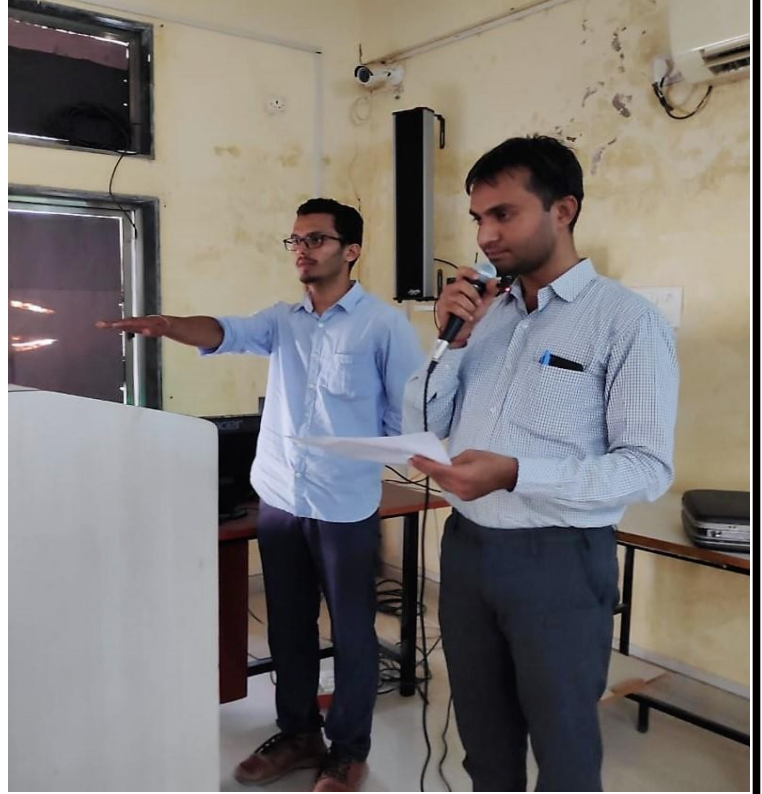
